STUDENT GUIDELINES

● Share your motivation

Talk with your child about why you enrolled them—this helps them feel involved and understand the value of learning French.

● Homework matters

It's not just extra work—it's essential for reinforcing what was learned in class and making real progress.

● Create a learning-friendly space

When learning from home, your child will need a quiet space that will help them stay focused and relaxed.

● No snacks during class

If your child's class is close to a meal time (breakfast, lunch), please make sure that your child has already eaten or eats after class.

● Let them explore

Unless required (like in Toddler classes), we recommend parents step back so the child feels free to participate naturally.

FRQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What does my child need for class?

Each class uses a specific textbook, which you can purchase at registration for approximately 60\$.

Q: My child is a beginner—will English be used?

Classes are mainly in French, but teachers speak English too. Students can ask questions in English if needed.

Q: What if the class is too easy or too hard?

If the level doesn't suit your child, let us know after the first couple of classes—we'll help find a better fit.

Q: What if my child misses a class?

Please notify the teacher in advance. They'll adjust the class accordingly and let you know what was covered.

Q: Do you offer language certifications?
